AT SHADMOOR STATE PARK

Observe and learn to identify birds throughout a variety of habitats, including woodland, grassland, wetland, and ocean species of Shadmoor State Park.

Fall Migration

Fall bird migration in Montauk is an ongoing event that can be enjoyed from mid-August through November. As many northern breeding songbird, landbird, and raptor species travel south along the Atlantic Flyway, Montauk's geographical features and location make it a favored stopover for birds to rest and refuel.
