- A rare Cassin's Sparrow continues at Montauk Point. This grayish-brown sparrow with a hint of an eyering is generally found in the Southwestern US, predominantly in Texas, New Mexico, and Mexico. This sighting is the first reported in Suffolk County and the second record in New York State. The vagrant was first documented in early December and has continued foraging near the stairs to the upper parking lot at the lighthouse.
